- We organise (inter)national scientific and educational exchange programmes in the field of IBD. We enhance the quality of research in the field of IBD, both in basic science (i.e. organising pathogenesis workshops) and clinical science (i.e. development of IBD study protocols).

- We take a political voice in Europe and collaborate with organisations sharing an interest in IBD including medical societies, patient organisations and industries.
- We participate in the activities of United European Gastroenterology (UEG) and in the organisation of the annual United European Gastroenterology Week (UEG Week).


Our mission

The ECCOmmittees

- Clinical Research Committee (ClinCom) advises on the design of IBD clinical studies in Europe through some of Europe's most experienced investigators.
- **Education Committee (EduCom)** educates specialists and trainees about IBD in all its aspects, through e-Learning (e-CCO), courses, national and international workshops.
- **Epidemiological Committee (EpiCom)** promotes epidemiological studies to understand the changing pattern and burden of IBD.
- Guidelines Committee (GuiCom) sets new standards by developing scientific guidelines that can be translated into practice.
- Nurses of ECCO (N-ECCO), the umbrella organisation of Clinical Nurse Specialists in IBD, creates a network of nurse professionals across Europe.
- Paediatricians of ECCO (P-ECCO) develops knowledge on IBD affecting children.
- Scientific Committee (SciCom) promotes scientific activities within the ECCO Community including Fellowships, Grants and Travel Awards.
- Surgeons of ECCO (S-ECCO) is dedicated to IBD surgery, its science and cooperation between surgeons and gastroenterologists.
- Young ECCO (Y-ECCO) is the platform for networking between young enthusiastic clinicians and scientists not older than 35 or still in training.

Dietitians of ECCO (D-ECCO) strives to improve the understanding of dietary therapy among physicians and dietitians.

Histopathologists of ECCO (H-ECCO) promotes cooperation between histopathologists and IBD experts by education and contribution to European histopathological research and guidelines in IBD.

In 2006, we published our ECCO Guidelines covering the diagnosis and current management of Crohn's Disease. Since then, many guidelines have been developed which have become standard references for IBD management in Europe and around the world.
