

⁴Students/PhD Students and holders of post-graduate non-medical degree professionally affiliated with field of IBD (e.g.: dietician, pharmacist, psychologist) may register for the Affiliate Non-Member Congress fee. All delegates registering at this fee must upload a certificate of their professional status/Student or PhD Student status during the registration process.

⁵Patient Advocates registering at this fee must upload a proof of their membership of a Patient Advocate Association during the registration process.
