The ECCO e-Guide 2.0 has been launched and introduces brand new IBD Calculators which are integrated into the e-Guide platform. The e-Guide contains twelve calculators – each of them is accompanied by an explanatory video featuring an ECCO Officer. The paediatric introductory videos will be recorded at ECCO'20 in February. The e-Guide 2.0 also has a fully refurbished section on therapeutic interventions which covers a wide array of drugs. Make sure you also look at the new disease algorithms which map out the management of both CD and UC. They are easy to navigate and very user friendly and have the appropriate statements from the relevant guidelines embedded within them.



ECCO Guidelines and Topical Reviews are traditionally accompanied by e-Courses developed by the Y-ECCO authors of these publications. Recently ECCO published the Guidelines on Therapeutics in Crohn's disease and hence two corresponding e-Courses were created – one on luminal disease, the other on perianal disease.


