



## ECCO CONFER Cases – Round 4: Call for similar cases

### Dear ECCO Members and friends,

Following the 3<sup>rd</sup> round, the European Crohn's & Colitis Organisation (ECCO) has launched the 4<sup>th</sup> round of the ECCO CONFER project. It aims to identify, assemble and report together rare IBD cases of clinical relevance, which are otherwise reported as single case reports due to their rarity. All such cases will be grouped into a case-series and all contributing physicians will be acknowledged as co-authors or as collaborating authors.

The four case projects which have been chosen for the 4<sup>th</sup> round are:

**Case 1: Drug Induced liver injury (DILI) with biologics**  
**Case 2: IBD and eosinophilic gastroenteritis (overlap cases)**  
**Case 3: Esophageal Crohn's Disease**  
**Case 4: Upper and lower extremities paresthesias under anti-TNFa therapy**
